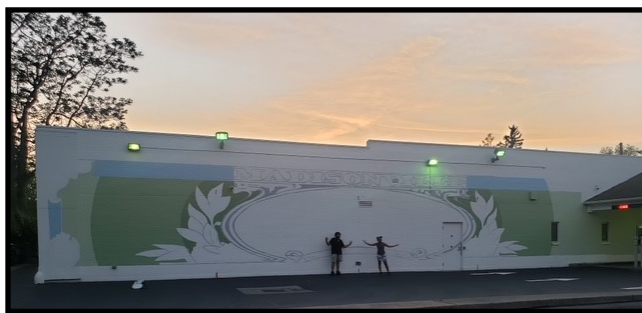


New Mural Celebrates Madisonville
