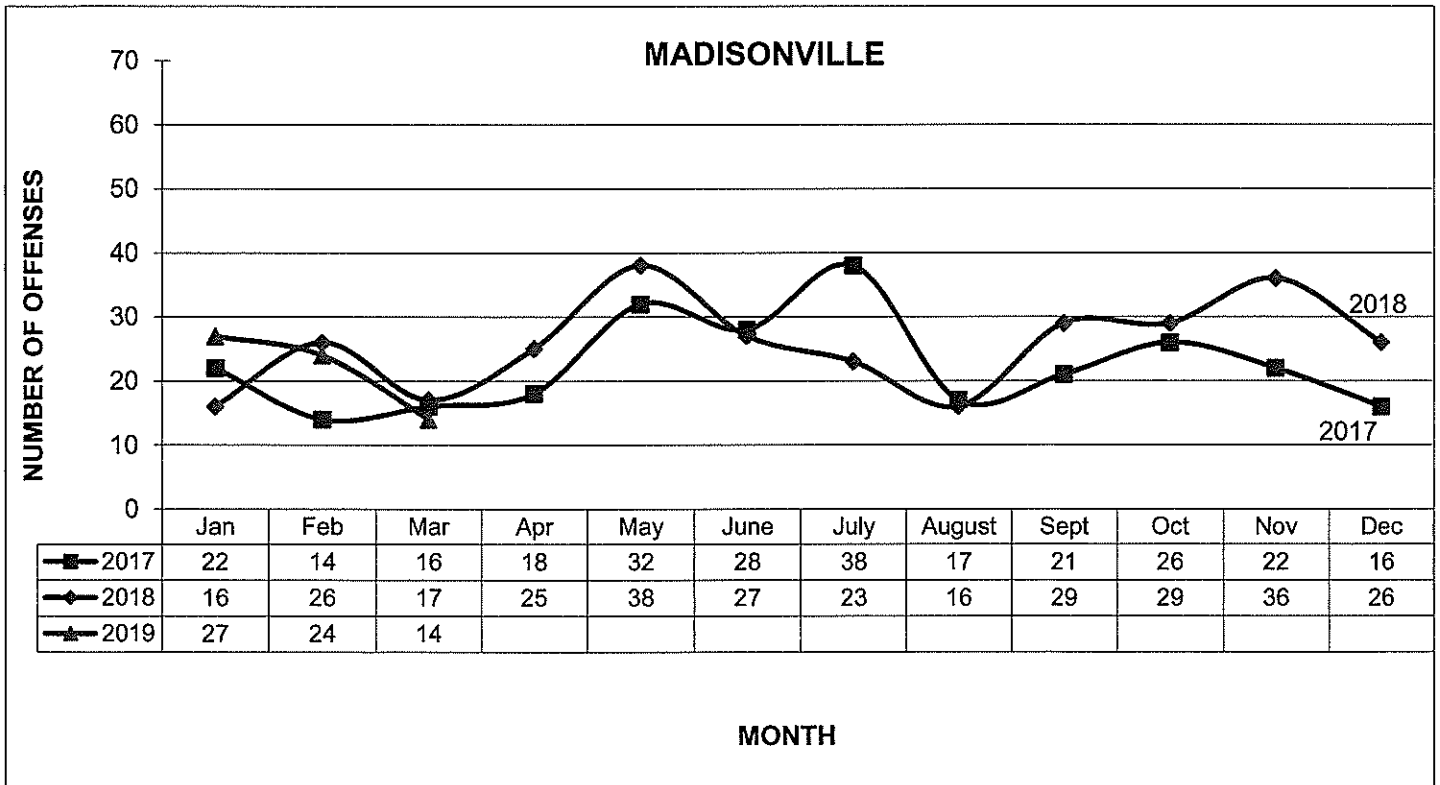

Ackermann's Corner Started as Small Grocery in 1911

The market had its beginning in 1911, 5909-11 Bramble Avenue, when John Ackermann Sr., founded his grocery, bakery

and confectionery in south Madisonville. The area then was sparsely populated. He operated the store until 1916 then turned it over to his youngest son Gene. During years past, Gene remodeled and enlarged to meet the growing demands of his customers. Store personnel too has grown, including Gene's wife Ruth, his two daughters, Catherine and Ann and his nephew Don. Gene is very proud of the 48 years in Madisonville and boasts having one of the oldest, yet newest markets in the area, reported 1959 Madisonville Sesquicentennial.

This building, storefront still stands in 2019, called many different names over the past 108 years as the anchor in Bramble / Whetsel business district.

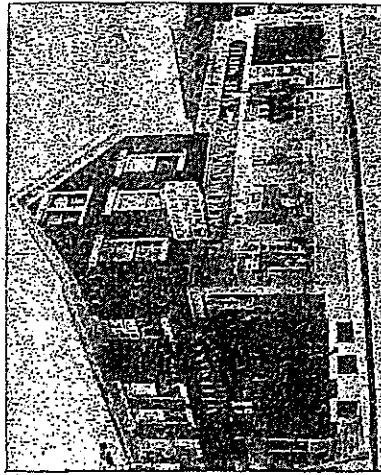

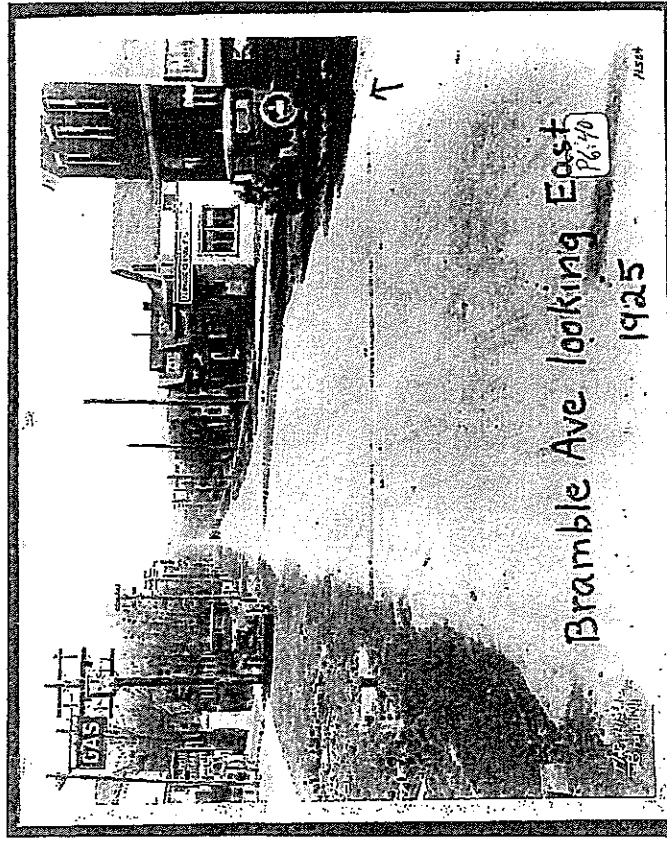
